

Grading: Final course grades will be based on 3 exams and 1 cumulative final exam, each worth 100 points, as outlined.

Exam I	(Ch. 1-6)	100 pts
Exam II	(Ch. 7-10)	100 pts
Exam III	(Ch. 11-15, 17-19)	100 pts
Final Exam	(cumulative)	100 pts
