## **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

Chem 2541 is the first semester of organic chemistry at the sophomore-junior level. The lecture portion of the course will cover covalent bonds and shapes of molecules, alkanes and cycloalkanes, stereochemistry and chirality, organic acids and bases, alkenes and electrophilic addition reaction, alkynes, haloalkanes and radical reactions, nucleophilic substitution and  $\beta$ -elimination, and alcohols.
