DEFINITIONS

This application is for undergraduate international students. U.S. citizens, permanent residents, and refugees should use the domestic application. If you are now or were ever previously enrolled in a degree program on any campus of the University of Minnesota, you should use a different application. (This does not include extension-only or summer-only students, who should use this application.) If you are applying to one of the professional schools (medicine, veterinary medicine, pharmacy, dentistry, or law), or to graduate level programs, you must submit separate applications.

CHECKLIST

Please submit the following items:

- **A completed application form, signed and dated.** You must complete all items with bold numerals.
- **A \$50 U.S. non-refundable application fee.** The fee should be payable to the University of Minnesota Duluth, in the form of a bank draft drawn on a U.S. bank or an international postal money order. Do not send cash. The fee cannot be waived. If you apply to more than one campus of the University, you must submit a separate fee and application to each campus.
- **Official transcripts and official English translations.** Transcripts of course work and grades are required for **four** years of secondary school study and from **all** post-secondary schools attended. An official transcript is one that contains the official stamp or seal of the school or is certified as official by the school, a U.S. embassy or consulate official, or other recognized international official. If you complete secondary school in a country where a secondary leaving examination is required for university entry, you will be required to provide us the results of this examination.
- **Test scores.** If your native language is not English, a Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or International English Language Testing System (IELTS) score is required. If you have studied in an English-speaking country at the university level for two years, the English testing requirement may be waived. **If you have less than one year of post-secondary studies, SAT or ACT with writing assessment examination results are strongly recommended (and are required for student athletes).**
- **Financial certification statement.** If you require an I-20 form for a student visa, you must provide documentation to show you have sufficient funds to cover at least your first year (12 months) of studies in the United States. Please submit a letter from your sponsor and current bank statements.

To avoid delays in processing your application:

- 1) Make sure you provide your permanent home address in your country of citizenship.
- 2) Check the box for your gender on the application form.
- 3) Make sure your name on this application matches your name as it will appear on your passport.
