

UMD Alumni Association Scholarship

The UMD Alumni Scholarship is the first that gives back specifically to children and grandchildren of UMD alumni. The scholarship provides the selected UMD sophomores, juniors, and seniors outreach opportunities as well as financial support. It encourages and fosters leadership. The goal of the scholarship is to provide financial support and significant leadership experiences.

Students must be in good academic standing with a GPA of 2.5 or better. The scholarship recipient(s) will be non-voting members of the UMD Alumni Association Board of Directors and will be provided networking opportunities with alumni.

Who can apply for the UMD Alumni Association Scholarship?

Children and grandchildren of UMD alumni with a GPA of 2.5 or better who will be a sophomore, junior, or senior at UMD in the fall of 2010.

What is the selection criteria for the UMD Alumni Association Scholarship?

In order to be considered a candidate for the UMD Alumni Association Scholarship, a UMD student must be:

- * A child or grandchild of UMD alumni
- * A full-time undergraduate UMD student
- * Able to maintain a GPA of 2.5 or better and be in good academic standing
- * In his/her sophomore, junior, or senior year of study at UMD
- * Able to demonstrate an/or describe his/her leadership skills and community service

How does the candidate apply for the UMD Alumni Association Scholarship?

Sign, complete, and mail the application form along with a copy of your transcript by Friday, March 19, 2010.

What is the scholarship amount?

The scholarship amount will be determined by the scholarship advisory committee and the University of Minnesota Duluth Alumni Board of Directors.

What are the recipient's responsibilities?

Scholarship recipients will be non-voting members of the UMD Alumni Association Board of Directors and are expected to attend the twice-yearly board meetings in Duluth. They will be provided networking opportunities with alumni, faculty and administration. They will be encouraged to participate in alumni activities and alumni board committees.

Is the scholarship renewable?

Yes, funds permitting. An updated application form must be submitted each year for consideration.
