The student will be permitted to register for no more than the number of classes required at their high school. That is, the number of classes at high school plus the number of classes at UMD may equal, but not exceed, the high school's requirement. For example, if they are required to take six classes and are registered for six in high school, they will need to drop a class in high school to take a class at UMD. It is the high school's responsibility to insure that the student does not exceed full time status. The high school counselor will receive a list of the student's UMD registration approximately three weeks after each semester begins.
