**HOW TO REGISTER:**

Go online to [www.ets.org/praxis](http://www.ets.org/praxis), click on **Register for a Test** under Praxis I, click on **Register Online** at the bottom of the page (You Must Have a Credit Card), Click **Sign Up** to create an account if you haven't done so already. After you account is created Sign into your account, Click on register for Praxis Paper Based Test, Click I Agree, Select Date, **Select Paper Based Test:** Enter Test Code in Test Code Box & Click Search, Add Test , Select Add another Test (Repeat Until Reading, Writing & Math are added), Click Continue. **Select Testing Location:** Select United States & Minnesota, Click Search, Check Box next to Duluth, Click Check Availability, Click Reserve a Seat, Click Continue. **Select Attending Institution:** Select United States & Minnesota, Click Search, Select Univ Minnesota Duluth (1207 Ordean CT, 120 Bohannon Duluth, MN 55812) Click Continue. **Select Score Recipients:** Select United States & Minnesota, Click Search, Select Univ Minnesota Duluth (1207 Ordean CT, 120 Bohannon Duluth, MN 55812), Click Continue. **Select Certifying Agency:** Select United States & Minnesota, Click Search, Select Minnesota Board of Teaching. **Demographic Questions: Answer Questions.** Click Check Out, Enter Credit Card Information, Print Admission Ticket (Bring to Testing Day)

**\*\*Tip** complete the [Praxis 2009-2010 Registration Form.pdf](#) (found under register by mail) first with all the codes then when you go to register online you will have all the information ready. **\*\*Session times out after 10 minutes, so be sure to at least move your mouse every once in a while otherwise you will have to start over again.**

Also, look at the documents titled: **Reducing Test Anxiety & General Information & Study Tips**

**How does the paper based version work?** Reading & Math Tests consists of 40 Multiple Choice Questions with 60 minutes of testing time. The Writing Test consists of two 30 minute sections of testing time one consisting of 38 multiple choice questions and the other is one essay.

**Accessing Scores after the Exam: All scores are now ONLY available online!**

A paper copy of the test scores will no longer be mailed to your house, instead you can log into your ETS account and access your scores online, be sure to save the PDF of your scores on your computer for your record. This can then be printed for the Block Application. **Scores are only available online 45 days from score report date (listed above).**

By Appointment. Prometric Testing Centers offers the Praxis I (PPST) Exam on a daily basis. Be sure to call a minimum of 2 weeks in advance to schedule your appointment to ensure computer availability.

**HOW TO REGISTER:**

You Must Call 1-800-853-6773 press option 3, state that you would like to register for the Praxis I (PPST) Computer Based Test. Also, state if you are taking the combined or separate exam.

Must have a credit card to register!

\*\*Tip complete the [Praxis 2009-2010 Registration Form.pdf](#) (found under register by mail) at [www.ets.org/praxis](http://www.ets.org/praxis) first with all the codes then when you go to register over the phone you will have all the information ready.

\*\*Be patient it normally takes 10-15 minutes before a representative will answer the telephone.

**COMBINED EXAM:** Reading/Writing/Math Combined Exam (Exam \$130, Registration Fee \$50=**\$180**)

**SEPARATE EXAM:** READING/WRITING/MATH SEPARATE EXAM: (Exam \$160, Registration fee \$50=**\$210**)

**INDIVIDUAL TESTING** (For Retaking a Section): (1 Test=**\$80**, 2 Tests=**\$120**)

**HOW DOES THE COMBINED COMPUTER BASED VERSION TEST WORK?**

The combined test will consist of four separately timed sections: Reading, Mathematics, Multiple-choice Writing, and Essay Writing. There will be an optional 15-minute break between the Mathematics and Writing Sections of the test. The testing session for the combined test is set for 4 1/2 hours completed one day. This allows enough time for tutorials and the collection of background information. The actual testing time for each section is the same as the individual tests. **The Education Department STRONGLY RECOMMENDS taking the combined version!**

**HOW DOES THE SEPARATE COMPUTER BASED VERSION TEST WORK?**

The separate exam will consist of taking the 3 parts on 3 separate days. You would do this if you want to spread the exam out over multiple days instead of taking all 3 parts on one day. The exam is still 4 1/2 hours like the combined exam, but you would be spending 75 minutes one day on the reading, 75 minutes one day on the math and 68 minutes one day for the writing, additional time is for computer tutorials and collection of background info.

**Accessing Scores after the Exam: All scores are now ONLY available online!**

A paper copy of the test scores will no longer be mailed to your house, instead you can log into your ETS account and access your scores online, be sure to save the PDF of your scores on your computer for your record. This can then be printed for the Block Application. **Computer Based Exam Scores are available 10-15 days after you complete the test. After scores have been posted they are downloadable and available online for 45 calendar days from the score post date.**
