
# "Sunday Memos"

When the semester starts the links on the memos will be "hot" (active) and they will take you to more detailed information.




It's fine for you to select the items that interest you most from each of the "Sunday Memos" (including this one).

### About the Anthropology of Food course . . .


Some people like to procrastinate. Others like to arrive early to a party, and in some ways those folks are "pre-crastinators".



That will make your life *much* easier. (Trust me.)







# Canvas "Modules" vs. "Sunday Memos"


