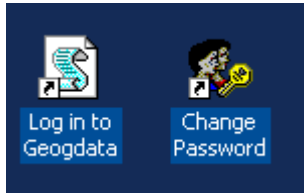


Logging in to GEOGDATA



For your first time login AND once every 365 days:

1) Double click on the Change password icon to remove the temporary/old password and assign a permanent/new one. (It is suggested that you use the same password as your X.500 or email password, as the username will be the same.)



- 2) Fill out the window using the above image as a template and use your username in the “User” box.
- 3) Type the temporary/old password appropriate to your class listed below in the “Old password” box and put your X.500 password in each of the “New Password” boxes.
- 4) Click the “Change Password” button and then click the “Close button to close the window.

Initial passwords on GEOGDATA

Your initial password will be your course number and semester in this format:

If you are in GEOG-4563 for fall 2008: GEOG4563_F08 (i.e. GEOG 5995: GEOG5995_F08, etc)

To map the drives:

- 1) Double-click on the “Log in to Geogdata” icon on the desktop.
- 2) Fill in your username and password to map the drives.

The “W:” and “X:” drive letters should now be mapped.

W: is mapped to “\userdata\username” and is your own personal storage space for your GIS related coursework.

X: is mapped to “\gdata” and is the GIS library of read-only data.
