- Position:** The Department of Education at the University of Minnesota Duluth is seeking applicants for Instructor or Assistant Professor Positions for the summer session 2008, fall semester 2008, and spring semester 2009.
- Responsibilities:** Responsibilities may include teaching courses in one or more of the following areas: elementary education, early childhood education, secondary education, special education, art education, human diversity, technology; advising education students; supervising student teacher candidates; serving on committees; and other duties as assigned.
- Qualifications:** Essential academic qualification to be eligible for the Instructor position is a Masters degree in education or field related to specific teaching assignment. Essential academic qualification to be eligible for the Assistant Professor position is a Doctorate in education or field related to specific teaching assignment.
- Essential experience for Instructor and Assistant Professor positions include: two years of teaching experience in P-12 school and/or at university level; experience and/or commitment to working with students from diverse population groups; and evidence of ability to integrate diversity issues into the curriculum.
- Desired experience for Instructor and Assistant Professor positions include: three or more years teaching experience in P-12 school and/or two or more years teaching experience at the university level; experience with and/or commitment to teaching technology and evidence of ability to integrate technology into the curriculum.
- Part-time temporary one semester positions, with the possibility of full time – temporary-Instructor or Assistant Professor positions in the Department of Education beginning June 9, 2008 for summer session, beginning August 25, 2008 for fall semester, and beginning January 12, 2009 for spring semester.
