<u>Family Time</u>	Age Range: Newborn-7 yrs. Class Length: 45 minutes	Movin' & Groovin' is a romping, rolling, stretching good time for the whole family. This unit will explore lots of different ways to move—high and low, fast and slow, zigzag and curvy, and more. Family members will chug around the classroom like trains, clip-clop like horses, and roll over like puppy dogs. They'll hear a story about playing tag together in <i>Can You Catch Me?</i> , and read about a jungle hokey-pokey in <i>Put Your Left Paw In</i> . Home Materials include two books— <i>Can You Catch Me?</i> and <i>Put Your Left Paw In</i> , two Home CDs, Family Guide, Rascal the monkey hand puppet and finger puppet, and two monkey den-den drums.
<u>Village</u>	Age Range: Newborn -18 months Class Length: 45 minutes	Research shows the more you expose your baby to nursery rhymes and songs, the stronger those emerging language-learning skills will be. That's why these Mother Goose-like stories and rhymes are the main theme of the Hickory, Dickory, Tickle, and Bounce unit. Plus, you'll develop research-proven communication strategies with your child through listening activities, speaking "parentese," and sign language. The Rhythm of My Day will help you bring more rhythm and routine to your baby's day, as well as help develop lasting learning skills. We'll show you how and tell you why music can help your little one soothe into the day's schedule and help build a strong body and mind network for learning. You can bring home those same stress-free play and relaxation techniques from class, and incorporate them into your daily routines. Home materials include two Home CDs of the songs and rhymes from class, two literature books, two sets of art banners, and two instruments.
<u>Our Time</u>	Age Range: 18 months-3 yrs. Class Length: 45 minutes	In the Fiddle-dee-dee unit of Our Time, we'll meet many animal characters in our books, activities, and songs—each specifically chosen for a toddler's emerging interests and physical skills. With silly, bumpy lap bounces we'll help toddlers develop rhythm while further developing their ever-emerging language skills. With a special stringed instrument emphasis in the music from class, parents can bring home the violin, cello, and orchestra sounds to help their toddlers stay happy and engaged learners at home, too. Home Materials include a double CD featuring songs from class; two interactive storybooks— <i>This Little Piggy Played the Fiddle</i> and <i>Animal Serenade</i> to develop early literacy skills; Home Activity Book, and a pair of Fiddlestick instruments.
<u>Imagine That</u>	Age Range: 3-5 yrs. Class Length: 45 minutes	In Cities! Busy Places, Friendly Faces , sidewalks, elevators, skyscrapers, and world-traveling photographers are the theme. Learning through the pretend play that preschoolers adore, we'll be rhythmically busy playing storytelling games and handcrafting city "buildings" at home so we can make a cityscape in class! Plus every activity has some at-home adaptations so the parent can take part in the learning. With a pair of resonator bars as a featured instrument, and a multicultural, jazzy collection of music, preschoolers will develop the social and intellectual skills they'll need in school. Home Materials include two books— <i>Razupazu Toto</i> and <i>Down Our Street</i> , Cities! game board set, two Home CDs, Family Activity Book, a pair of resonator bars, and a backpack.
<u>Young Child</u>	Age Range: 5-7 yrs. Class Length: 60 minutes	Playing simple musical patterns and songs on the glockenspiel is a central focus Semester 2 . While learning to sing a melody, and then play the pattern on the glockenspiel, we'll delve deeper into the understanding of musical concepts such as piano and forte through orchestra-style music such as the William Tell Overture and Peter and the Wolf. Music appreciation and understanding continues with a complete introduction to the instruments—and the families in which they're grouped—of the orchestra. Home materials include a children's folder with stickers, games bag, Music At Home Cards, family songbook, and a Home CD of music from class. New students also receive a glockenspiel and carry bag.
<u>Sign & Sing</u>	Age Range: 6 months-3 yrs. Class Length: 45 minutes	In weeks one through five of this special 10-week class, playtime and everyday items around the house—such as a ball, bubbles, and family members—are learning themes in this introduction to American Sign Language for a child and caregiver. Parents will benefit from the session's four, research-proven strategies shown to speed language development in hearing children, developed by the child development and sign language experts Signing Smart™. With the DVD's visual dictionary showing parents and children making over 60 signs, plus a pocket-sized set of flashcards of the pictures and the words of the signs, parents easily incorporate sign language into their daily routines, favorite nursery rhymes, and stories.
