



Bicycle Storage Locker

As an alternative to bike racks, UMD has bike lockers available for rent. Six lockers are located beneath the Dining Center. They are durable storage units allowing for safe, individual storage of your bicycle away from the weather elements. Bike lockers may be leased from the Cashiers in Darland Administration Building. Monthly fees are charged in advance with a refund for any unused months. The rental fee includes a refundable deposit for the return of the locker key. All rates include sales tax.

Current rates are as follows:

\$8 x 3 months (September - November)	\$24.00
\$4 x 4 months (December - March)	\$16.00
\$8 x 5 months (April - August)	\$40.00
Key Deposit (refundable)	\$25.00
Total annual fee	\$105.00

2009 UMD Bicycle Regulations

Biking is a great for you, your wallet, and your carbon footprint, but it's important to follow these regulations to ensure the safety of all campus users.

- "Bicycle" means a device propelled solely by human power upon which a human can ride.
- Please park bicycles only in designated parking areas. No bicycles locked to trees or any plant material.
- All persons operating a bicycle shall do so in a careful and prudent manner.
- No riding on sidewalks, crosswalks, or pedestrian areas unless accessing a bicycle storage area.
- No bicycles in classrooms, auditoriums, laboratories or hallways.
- No blocking doors, ramps, stairs, sidewalks, or fire hydrants.

- UMD Police may confiscate any bicycle parked in violation of the Traffic Regulation Ordinance #3. Bicycles may be disposed of after 30 days if not claimed with satisfactory proof of ownership.
