

**UMD Seminar Quick Guide**  
**SSP: 1000 UMD Seminar**  
**Offered in the department: Supportive Services Program**

**Sections 001 - 034 and 044** are *regular, open sections* for everyone.

**Section 035** is for *Students of Color*. Any student of color can choose to take this course. Some students are part of the MEP program and will be in this section if their schedule allows it. These students received a letter asking them to take this section. If there are questions, contact Danny Frank or Susana Pelayo Woodward.

**Section 036 and 037** are for *fall varsity athletes*. Those students who play on the intercollegiate football, soccer, or volleyball teams will be placed in it this summer. As a placeholder, please have them choose a regular section (Sections 1-34) that fits with their schedule.

**Sections 038, 039, 040, 043** are for *LSBE students*. Members of the staff or faculty in LSBE teach these sections.

**Sections 041 and 042** are *living/learning* sections, which means that the student is choosing to be in class with the people they live with on their residence hall floor. Class will meet in the Griggs P-Q Lounge. Students who choose this option must submit a housing contract by May 1.

**Section 044** is a *regular, open sections* for everyone.

**Sections 045-049** are for *SFA students*. Please put them in the appropriate class by major. Members of the staff or faculty in SFA teach these sections.

**Section 050** is for *International Students*. These students will be placed in the course by staff in International Student Services.

**Section 051** is for *SCSE students*. SCSE students are not required to take this course, but it is a wonderful option for them to choose to be in a section with all SCSE students.

**Section 052, 053, 054** are for *CEHSP Early Childhood and Elementary Education Majors*. Members of the faculty or staff in these departments teach these sections.

**Sections 055-066** are part of the *Combo Pilot*. Students will have 50 minutes per week in a large group setting with guest speakers from across campus. They will also have 50 minutes in a small seminar setting for further reflection and application of the material. This course will have less outside coursework than the traditional section expectations.

Sections 55- 60—Large Group (lecture) will meet on Tuesdays from 2:00-2:50 in MWAH 195. The Seminar portion of the class will meet on Wednesdays.

Sections 61- 66—Large Group (lecture) will on Tuesdays from 3:00-3:50 in MWAH 195. The Seminar portion of the class will meet on Wednesdays.
