The UMD Study Abroad Scholarship application can be used for consideration for all of the university scholarships listed below for which you are eligible.

UMD Study Abroad Scholarship

Eligibility: Student must be enrolled as an UMD degree-seeking undergraduate going on an IEO approved study abroad program with a minimum of three credits and ten days in length.

UMN University-wide Scholarship

Eligibility: Student must be enrolled at one of the University of Minnesota system campuses going on an approved study abroad program. Non-UMD student: please see this website for the appropriate form and submission instructions: <http://www.umabroad.umn.edu/financial/scholarships/uofmScholarships.html>. Only credit bearing study abroad programs of at least 3 credits AND 3 weeks will be considered.

UMD AustraLearn and AsiaLearn Scholarship

Eligibility: UMD enrolled student must be participating on an AustraLearn or AsiaLearn program in Australia, New Zealand or Asia. Funding for this scholarship is provided by AustraLearn and AsiaLearn and varies from year to year.

UMD University Study Abroad Consortium (USAC) Scholarship

Eligibility: UMD enrolled student must be participating on an USAC program. Funding for this scholarship is provided by USAC and varies from year to year.

UMD Alworth Institute Study Abroad Scholarship

Eligibility: UMD enrolled student demonstrating an interest in acquiring international experience such as attending events at the Alworth Institute. The successful applicant will be expected to keep a learning journal reflecting upon the experience of operating in a foreign environment and will submit the journal to the Alworth Institute on completion of the study abroad program.

Who should use this application?

This application should only be used by students who are enrolled at UMD for a UMD degree and who will be studying abroad on an IEO approved study abroad program. Applicants will be considered for all UMD scholarships for which they are eligible (see listing). Application may be made prior to acceptance into a program, however, awards will only be credited to the account of the student enrolled in the study abroad program.

What is a complete application?

- Complete and signed UMD Study Abroad Scholarship Application form
- One essay answering five questions: 1. Why you selected your chosen program, 2. How you are preparing or will prepare to maximize your learning during the study abroad program, 3. How the program will impact you as a person, 4. How the program will impact your academic goals, 5. How the program will impact your long term goals.

Please include your name and student ID number in the upper right corner.

When should I submit the scholarship application?

Deadlines will depend on your program date (see below). Check the term you plan to be abroad, indicate year and note application deadline.
