Advanced Searching



Step 1: What is *Academic Search Premier* and how do you access it?

Academic Search Premier is a multi-subject database. To access *Academic Search Premier*, go to UMD Library's Homepage (<http://d.umn.edu/lib>) and click on our Databases page. Go to *Academic Search Premier* and click on the link.

Step 2: Advanced Search

Choose the term(s) you want to search and place them in the search box(es). You have a choice of searching for your terms as keywords (default) or you may click on the drop down menu arrow and choose a specific field to search, such as author, title or subject. When you have the terms filled in, click on "Search" to perform your search.

Step 3: Limiting Your Search

You can limit your search by checking the boxes in the area of information below the initial search fields. Below are some of the ways you can limit your search. PLEASE NOTE: It is NOT a good idea to limit your search to full text only.

Step 4: Retrieving your Article

Below is an example of a search result. If the citation includes links for "HTML Full Text", "PDF Full Text" or "Linked Full Text", you can click the link and retrieve the article. If the citation has a  button, click on it and see if UMD Library has the article in another database or in paper. If we don't have the article electronically or in print, you can request the item through Interlibrary Loan for free (10 business days are needed).
