Title: **Impervious Storage/Parking Areas**

Target Audience: University Employees
Auxiliary Services

Description: Identify and prioritize maintenance related issues for storm water run-off from impervious surfaces.

Measurable Goals:

1. Identify the issues with impervious storage/parking areas
2. Identify affected entities.
3. Create maintenance procedure for these areas
4. Educate users of parking areas regarding vehicle maintenance issues and long term storage of unused equipment

Timeline:

- May 2006
- July 2006
- February 2007
- April 2007

Specific Components:

- FM and Auxiliary Services to identify and prioritize storm water issues in regards to parking and storage areas.
- Create working group of affected entities to define issues of each regarding parking and long term storage.
- Create solutions to help reduce storm water pollution from impervious areas
- Provide procedures and training for staff and students regarding storm water run-off from impervious surfaces.
- Create and implement a policy regarding storage of equipment and materials in parking areas. (See 606 - Dumpster Management)

Educational Components:

- Inform university employees, A/Es, and contractors through email, website, and meetings.
