Target Audience: University Employees

Measurable Goals:

Timeline:

- September 2004
- December 2004
- March 2005
- April 2005

Specific Components:

- Review current practices. (Frequency).
- Make recommendation for changes in current practice.
- Auxiliary Services and FM to review recommended practice.
- Document recommendation decisions
- Implement agreed procedure.
- Provide training for employees.
- Refer to Mpls. procedure for recommendations.

Educational Components:

- Inform university employees and maintenance contractors through email, website, and/or meetings.
