If you are interested in building upon the A.A. degree you have earned from your institution, enroll in our program today and complete your major online.

## WHY PSYCHOLOGY WITH UMD?

We provide students with a firm grounding in methods, history, and content areas of the discipline. Graduates are prepared for graduate study leading to advanced degrees in psychology or for paraprofessional positions requiring some application of research or human service delivery skills.

## IS THIS PROGRAM FOR YOU?

To become successful within an online learning environment, you need to be a highly motivated person, a self starter, and have great time management skills. Each online course is designed differently, but all coursework can be completed without having to come to campus. You will need to have reliable computer access at all times and will be part of an online virtual learning community. All online courses follow the regular UMD semester start and end dates.

## ADMISSION AND TRANSFER

This online major is designed for students with an Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree or the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MTC). This program starts every Fall Semester. All applicants must meet UMD undergraduate admission and graduation criteria. Credits will transfer according to the transfer agreements with UMD.

\*\*Provide evidence of completion of your Associates of Arts (AA) Degree or Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MTC) with an official college transcript.

\*\*Provide evidence of high school degree by submitting high school transcript.

\*You must have taken the following classes during high school or college

\*4 Years English

\*3 years of math (algebra, intermediate algebra & geometry)

\*3 years of science (biological & physical science)

\*3 years of social studies

\*2 years of a singles second language

**\*NOTE:** Students who graduated from high school before 1987 are not expected to meet the high school requirements.
