

PEGGY L. SCHELLER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Peggy L. Scheller Memorial Scholarship was established by her family to support MSW students who are committed to providing outreach services in rural areas. Students who travel long distances to attend the UMD Masters of Social Work program and who plan to practice in small communities and rural areas are encouraged to apply.

Eligibility: MSW student in good academic standing with interest in rural outreach services.

Application process:

MSW students should submit a one page written statement describing their interest as well as any experience in social work practice and rural outreach services. Applicants should clearly describe their career goals and their commitment to rural practice.

A written letter of application should include a commitment to register for a minimum of 6 credits during the semester that the award is received. Students should also include information regarding other financial aid awards or scholarships that they have received for their graduate study.

The broad criteria for making the award include the quality of the written statement, clarity of career goals, and demonstrated commitment to rural outreach services.

Awards for the 2009-2010 academic year will be \$400. **Note:** If you're receiving the maximum financial aid this award could affect your loan amount.
