## ***Did you know...***

\$2 per pay period (\$52 in a year) can provide:

- At least 260 meals through a food bank.
- Lab fees to an African American college student.
- Backpacks and school supplies for 2 youngsters whose families have fled domestic violence.
- Two water quality tests in a Minnesota River threatened by pollution, the first step in cleaning them up.

\$5 per pay period (\$103 in a year) can provide:

- Emergency safe shelter for a mother and her two children for one day.
- At least 650 meals through a food bank.
- Tools for volunteers doing a community tree planting to replace trees lost to storms, insects or urban sprawl.
- One text book for an African American college student.
