1. Salary Increases and Back Pay

The 1% across the board increases will begin showing up on your January 22, 2014 paycheck. In addition, that check will include back pay for the increase from July 29, 2013 and the \$400 lump sum for those who are no longer receiving step increases. If you would

like to reduce the amount taken out in taxes for that pay check, you can change your withholding by going to Employee Self Service and following the W-4 Tax Information Update link. To change the information for that paycheck only, update the info before mid-day Wednesday, January 15. Don't forget to change your withholding back to the standard amount after January 22.

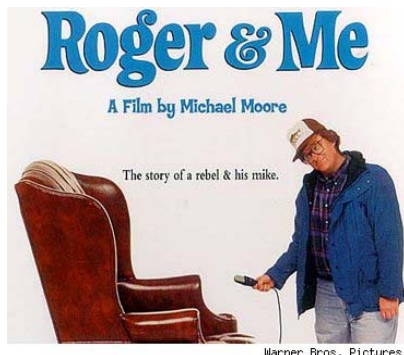
The University does not automatically process retro pay for bargaining unit people who have left the University since July 1, 2013. If you are in contact with a former AFSCME or Teamster worker, tell them to make a request to their old department in WRITING (email would count) to have their retro pay processed.

The 2% step increases should occur automatically on your anniversary date. Several people contacted us because they did not receive their step increases as scheduled and we were able to help them fix the problem. 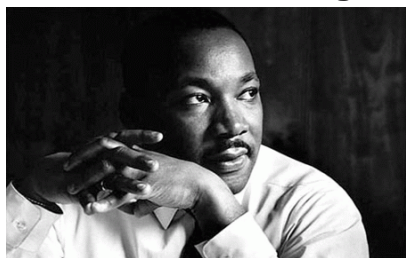
2. Labor Movie Night - Jan 17, Roger & Me
