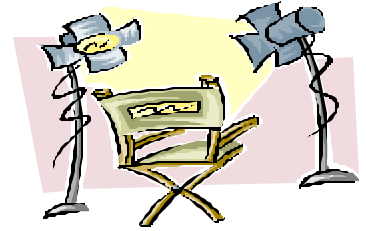

Robert Pike

One of the original 8 founders of Alpha Nu, Robert Pike graduated from UMD in December, 1960. During his senior year he served as president of the Kirby Student Center. He began teaching Junior High Math and Industrial Arts at Richfield Public Schools in September 1961. In between times he was earning his teaching certificate at the U of M as well as taking classes towards his Masters Degree. He received his Masters Degree in 1973 by going to summer school at Bemidji State and living in a campground with his wife, Herta and their 4 children. He and Herta have been married 42 years. Their oldest son, Tom, had 4 children and lives in Centerville, VA. Tim lives in Winnemucca, NV. He has 2 children. Daughter Sheryl lives in Midland, MI and Susan, a teacher lives in Carson City, NV. She was recently married.

Bob retired from teaching in June, 1993, but still keeps his hands in education by teaching basic home repair in various suburbs during October, February and May. While at Richfield, he coached the girl's volleyball team and was also the ski advisor. He and Herta chaperoned many downhill ski trips to Colorado, Northern Michigan and Minnesota during those years. He still skis and even races three times a week at Hyland Hills and Buckhill. He is trying to convince Herta to join him this year. For the last ten years he has been the project manager at Hope Presbyterian Church for the Habitat for Humanity program. 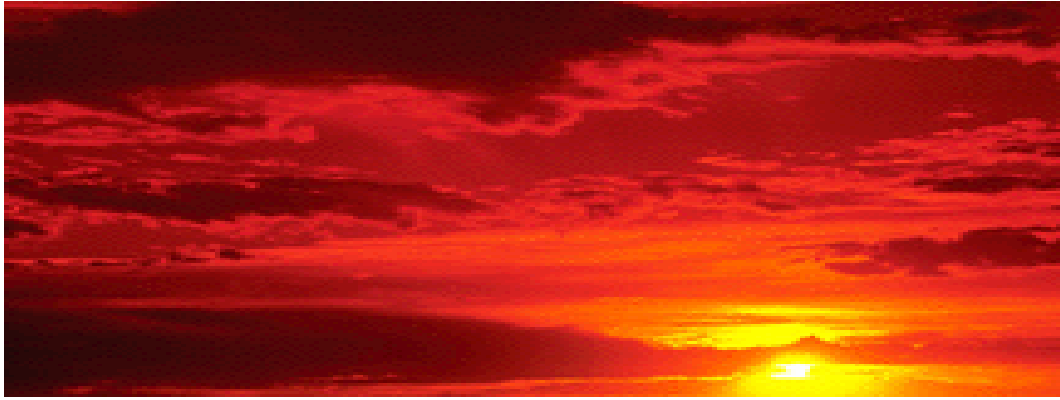

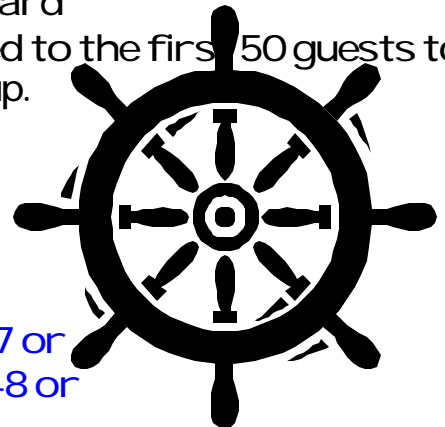
