

Donald B. Crouch

Brief Biography

Donald Crouch is a Professor of Computer Science at the University of Minnesota Duluth. He has an undergraduate degree in physics and a master's degree in mathematics from Lamar University. He received his Ph.D. in systems engineering from Southern Methodist University. Dr. Crouch has served on the faculties of the University of Florida, University of Alabama, Cornell University, and Tulane University and as Head of Computer Science at the University of Alabama and UMD. Prior to entering academia he was a member of the technical staffs of Texas Instruments, United Aircraft, and University Computing. Recently, he was on the Executive Committee and the Advisory Board of the Northland Advanced Transportation Systems Research Laboratories (2001-2008) and was an ABET Program Evaluator (1998-2008). His current research focuses on issues of information retrieval and RWIS sensor reliability. The National Science Foundation, Air Force Office of Scientific Research, Office of Naval Research, the Department of Transportation, and the Minnesota Department of Transportation have funded his research projects.
