

Help Locked-Out Sugar Workers



Union workers at Crystal Sugar were locked out of their jobs August 1 after rejecting the company's final contract offer.

Private security escorted union workers out before replacement workers arrived by the busload at sugar factories in Moorhead, East Grand Forks, Crookston and Chaska. Instead of letting 1,300 people continue working while a fair contract is negotiated, sugar executives have decided to hurt our communities with an unnecessary lockout.

Sugar workers want a contract that doesn't put their jobs in jeopardy and health coverage that won't put their families in financial ruin if someone gets sick.

Sugar workers stood by AFSCME during the shutdown – now it's our turn to stand with them.
