| Setting Components: Biophysical Social & Managerial | Area is characterized as a modified natural environment; Resource management practices focus on maintaining soil & vegetation in heavily used areas; Sights & sounds of humans are readily apparent; facilities are designed for use by a large number of people; facilities for overnight camping, picnicking and parking are available. | Area is characterized by a predominantly natural-appearing environment with moderate evidences of humans. Concentration of users is most often along shorelines & rivers. Area is managed with minimum onsite controls. | Area is characterized by essentially natural environment & interactions between users is low, but there is often evidence of other users (trails); visitors primarily encounter others at the Tettagouche camp area. | Area is characterized by essentially unmodified natural environment. Interaction between users is very low. Area is managed primarily as a natural area; motorized use is not permitted. |
