AVISO!

One of the main complaints regarding Canvas is that it is difficult to find assignments.

Right now, before you do anything else, do this to fix that problem . . .

Go to the "Calendar" Section (using the Global Navigation Panel) in your canvas folder @ <u>http://canvas.umn.edu/</u> ...



REM: Links on screenshots are not "hot" (active), but when you are looking at items in your Canvas folder you can generally click on them to take you to the item . . .

REM: Ignore the little messages that say "due 8:01", "due 1:01", etc. Those are a current quirk of the Canvas automatic systems.

And your Canvas calendar will look like the screenshot below . . .



When you get to the "Calendar" page, check out your options . . .

Then select "Agenda" at the top (shown on the following screenshot) . . .

Clicking on "Agenda" will give you a notebook style listings view . . .



And the Agenda version will look like this . . .



REM: Ignore the little messages that say "due 8:01", "due 1:01", etc.
