


“Sunday Memos”

The “**Sunday Memos**” are .pdf memos, like this one, that arrive by e-mail (usually, as you might expect, on Sunday).

And they are also featured each week in the “Recent Announcements” section at the top of your Canvas “Home Page” and in your “Announcements” folder (where Canvas keeps all of the past Announcements).

REM: Links on screenshots are not “hot” (active)

When the semester starts the links on the memos will be “hot” (active) and they will take you to more detailed information.



It’s fine for you to select the items that interest you most from each of the “Sunday Memos” (including this one).

You do not have to read them from beginning to end.

They start with links that take you directly to the part(s) that you might be interested in.

General Comments for the Week

As mentioned in my first memo, you can see in the newspapers and other media that lots of interesting things are happening in the world of the Anthropology of Europe. For an up-to-date review of what’s happening in Europe see [BBC News Europe](#) (from the world’s largest broadcast news organization, required by Royal Charter to report impartially), or have a look at the UK News from [The Guardian](#) (“center-left, with exceptional reporting” / liberal), and [The New York Times](#).

Also as mentioned, there is an excellent [Media Bias Chart](#) available to help you sort out the fake news from the rest, and to give you some indicating of the biases of others not regarded as purveyors of fake news and “alternative facts.” When looking up information for this course, try to stay with the sources listed inside of the green triangle at the very top on the Media Bias Chart.

click on the “Collapse All” button in the upper right-hand corner to de-clutter your screen.


That will make your life *much* easier.

(Trust me.)




(Sorry; Canvas does not permit instructors to set the default to open with all modules closed.)


Your de-cluttered Canvas “**Modules**” folder will then look something like this . . . :




VOILA!

contain the basic information, but the **“Sunday Memos”** have


more detail, some background, some studying suggestions, and, generally, some good images.
