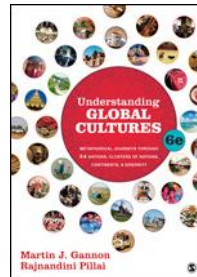

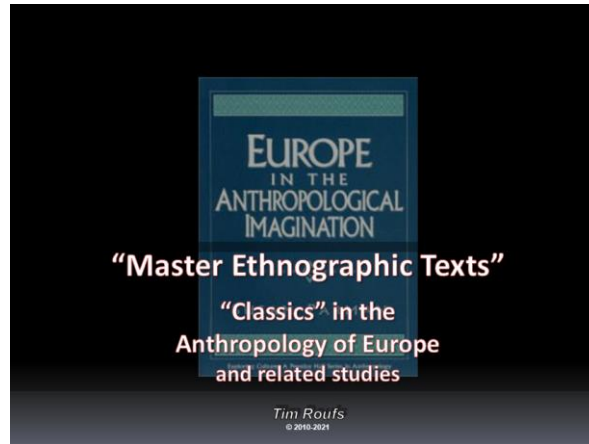

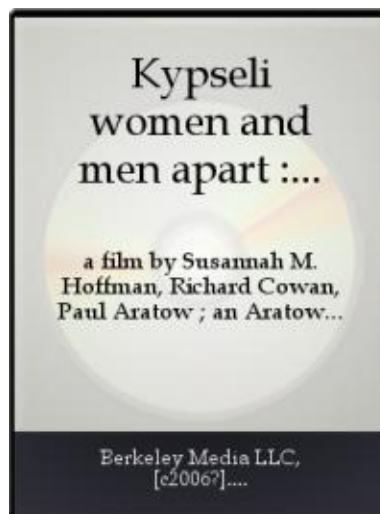


## What is a “Master Text”?

**QUESTION: How are the “Master Texts” relevant to today's Anthropology of Europe?**

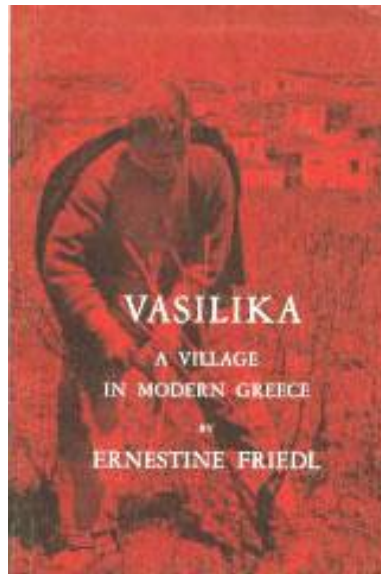
*Kypseli*, for e.g., is a “**master text**”.





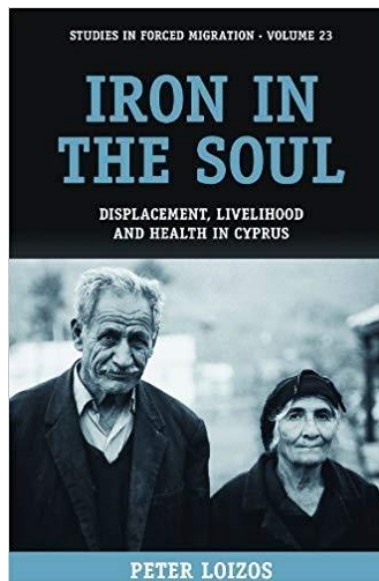
Ernestine Friedl's

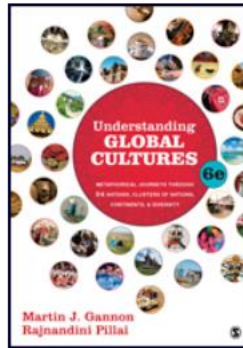

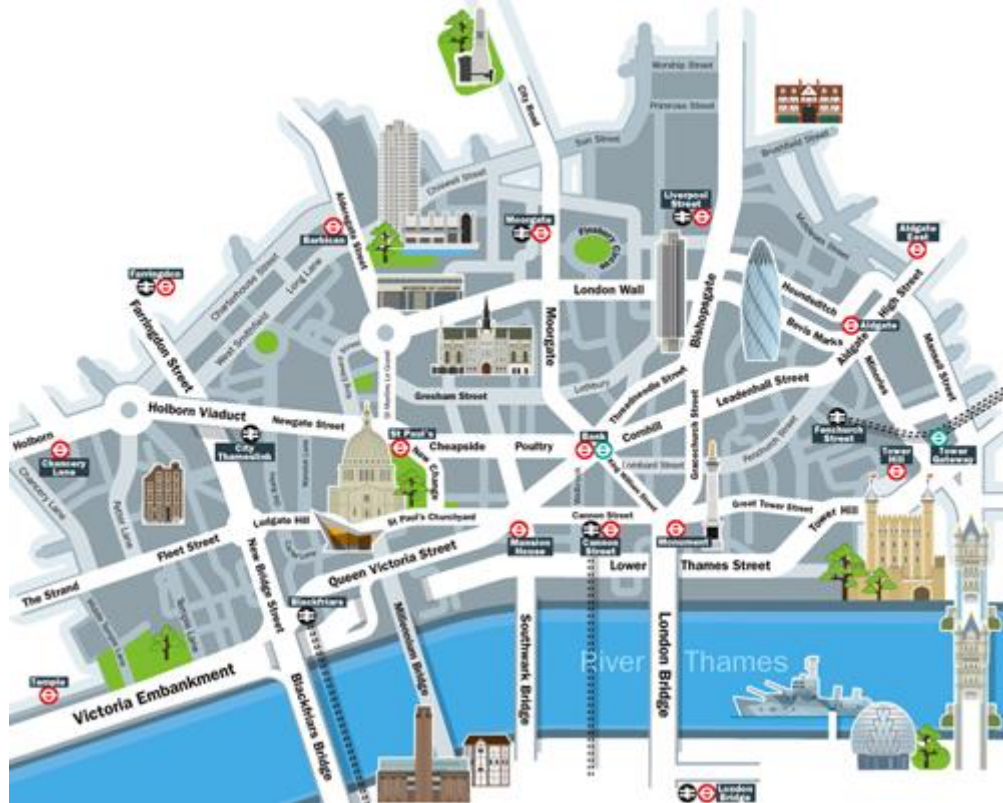
