## WHAT IS IT?

RaiseMe is a free micro-scholarship platform where you can earn money for doing well in classes, visiting colleges, and participating in extra-curricular activities.


## WHO IS IT FOR?

**High school students** (who can start their RaiseMe profile as early as the ninth grade) with a 3.2 or higher core GPA.

**Transfer students** who are applying from 2-year community or technical schools with a 3.5 or higher cumulative GPA and 26 or more completed credits.

Eligibility for scholarship consideration is contingent upon admission and enrollment at UMD.

## **HOW DOES IT WORK?**

Students see a list of goals recommended by colleges. Students enter achievements into their RaiseMe portfolio, and earnings are displayed as they enter content. When students apply to UMD and complete their RaiseMe profile by the priority deadline, they will be considered for merit scholarships.

## WHEN IS IT DUE?

In order to be considered for UMD's merit scholarships, you must complete your RaiseMe profile by the priority application deadline of the semester for which you're applying to UMD.
